



English

Maths

We base our lessons on the While Rose Maths scheme of learning. This half term, this includes fractions:

- Finding equivalent fractions
- Comparing and ordering fractions
- Adding and subtracting fractions
- Converting between improper fractions mixed numbers

Science

Our topic is forces, including:



- gravity
- air resistance, water resistance and friction
- mechanisms using levers, pulleys and gears

PSHE/RSE



- Ourselves, growing and changing: Biological changes that happen during puberty, personal hygiene routines, where to get information.
- Keeping safe: Body autonomy, protecting personal information online.

Geography

Our topic is 'Fantastic Journeys: Where could we go?', with objectives including:

- Longitude, latitude and time zones
 - Biomes and climate zones
- Human and physical features of amazing places around the world.

Computing

Our topic is: Computing systems and networks - Systems and searching.

This includes how physical and digital systems work together; how to search the internet safely & appropriately and how search results are ranked and influenced.





Art

Our topic is 'installation art'.

We will be looking at existing examples of installation art, before designing and creating our own.
