## **English**



This half term, we will creating Bonfire Night poems.

We will be reading 'How to Catch Santa' by Jean Reagan. The children will be learning how to write letters and create a set of instructions.

#### **Maths**

We will be continuing our Maths topic, addition and subtraction.

Our next topic this term is shape, the children will learn about 2D and 3D shapes.



#### **Science**

In this term, children build on learning from Year 1 about different materials and their properties. The children will have an understanding of simple physical properties of materials and their uses.

# PSHE/RSE

We are continuing to learning about keeping ourselves healthy and safe including the roles of medicine, the importance of keeping safe in different situations and the different rules for keeping safe.

# **History**

Our topic this half term is 'Which place are significant to me and why? The children will learn about significant events, people and places in their own locality- The Great North East.

# Computing

We are learning about computer systems and networks. The children will be naming some features of a computer, recognise the buttons cause effects and learning that technology follows instructions. They will understand the role of the computer in the world.
