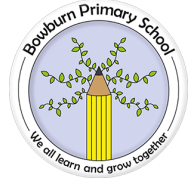




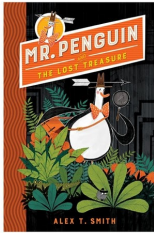

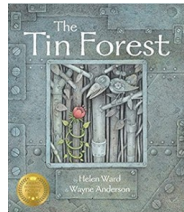
What's On

English



This half term we will be reading Mr Penguin and the Lost Treasure and The Tin Forest. All our writing will be themed around these books.



Maths

Our first Maths topic is Addition and Subtraction.
Our second Maths topic is Multiplication and Division.



Science



We are learning all about rocks, soil and fossils. We will learn to identify different types of rocks; how soil is made; how fossils are formed.

PSHE/RSE

We are continuing our topic about keeping ourselves healthy and safe as well as growing and changing. We will learn about making important choices; getting enough sleep; keeping our teeth clean; responsibility; and being safe around medicines.



Geography



Our topic this half term is 'Is the UK the Same Everywhere?' We will learn about physical or human features around the UK; identify rivers, mountains, landmarks; find out about weather around the UK and learn why the weather is changing, and we will learn about counties.
