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English

Our class novels this half term are:

Science

Our topic is Properties and Changes of Materials, including:

- Test & compare materials based on their hardness, solubility, transparency, conductivity and response to magnets
- Use knowledge of solids, liquids and gases to decide how mixtures can be separated, through filtering, sieving and evaporating.

History

Our topic is 'The Victorians', with objectives including:

- When and what was the Victorian era?
- What was Britain's Industrial Revolution and who was Isambard Kingdom Brunel?
 - What was life like for Victorian children?



Design and Technology

Our topic is 'mechanical systems: pop-up books'.

The children will be designing and making pop-up books using different folding, rotating and lever mechanisms.

French
