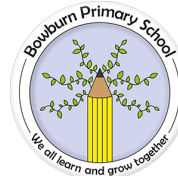




# Nursery (Penguins)Autumn 1



## What's On

This half term our topic is All About Me and Where I Live.

PE days are Monday morning and Friday afternoon.

### Class Stories

Our main story will be The Little Red Hen but we will also be reading books and stories about ourselves.



### Number

We will develop fast recognition of up to 3 objects, without having to count them individually (known as 'subitising').



We will recite numbers past 5.

We will show 'finger numbers' up to 5.



### Understanding the World

We will begin to make sense of our own life-story and family history.

We will show interest in different occupations.

### Personal Social and Emotional Development

We will develop a sense of responsibility and membership of a community.

We will become more outgoing with unfamiliar people, in the safe context of our setting.

### Physical Development

We will continue to develop movement, balancing, riding (scooters, trikes and bikes) and ball skills.

We will skip, hop, stand on one leg and hold a pose for a game like musical statues.

### Literacy

We will think about the five key concepts of print:

- print has meaning
- print can have different purposes
- we read English text from left to right and from top to bottom
- the names of the different parts of a book
- page sequencing.



### Expressive Art and Design

We will take part in simple pretend play, using an object to represent something else even though they are not similar.

We will begin to develop complex stories using small world equipment like animal sets, dolls and dolls houses, etc

### Music

We will remember and sing entire songs.



### Class Visitor

We will have visits from police dogs Jet and Ben and also the Mayor of Durham.
